The Outcalt Foundation embraces and supports the strength of the San Luis Valley and all other communities in Colorado. Through various statewide initiatives the Foundation is the model for demonstrating hope in practice by directly supporting individuals and organizations that are capable and committed to the advancement of community. The San Luis Valley Student Achievement Scholarship aligns with our mission in supporting extraordinary students to experience and achieve their full potential. These individuals will be the pillars of communities worldwide and we applaud those proud of being a citizen of the San Luis Valley.

Scholarship:

The Outcalt Foundation is organized to receive and administer funds for charitable purposes, including but not limited to the fostering of educational opportunities for the advancement and benefit of secondary education and post secondary education students by providing financial support for post secondary education in various levels of learning institutions within the United States of America. This year, the Foundation anticipates awarding up to four (4) \$5,000 scholarships, to qualifying secondary education seniors and post secondary education students graduating from a San Luis Valley institution of learning. The funds awarded are to be used for tuition, mandatory fees, course-related expenses, and reasonable living expenses incurred to attend an accredited college or university within the United States. Unsuccessful applicants may apply multiple times if all other scholarship requirements are met.

Criteria for selection:

- Academic achievement
- Financial need
- Letter of recommendations (from secondary education or post secondary education faculty, community leaders and/or honored individuals)
- Experience and commitment to serving the broader San Luis Valley community and
- Application essay.

Award:

The Board of Trustees will appoint a scholarship committee to review applications for the annual Outcalt Foundation Student Achievement Scholarships.

- This committee may consist of Board Trustees or others whom the Board of Trustees feel qualified to provide unbiased recommendations.
- This committee shall make a recommendation to the Board of Trustees which applicants should be awarded annual scholarships based upon the criteria established by the Board of Trustees.

All successful scholarship awards are at the discretion of the Board of Trustees and all decisions are final.

If an applicant believes they were not properly and fully considered for a scholarship award, they must file a written grievance within 30 days of the scholarship award date with the Board of Trustees.

- The Board of Trustees shall review the complaint and make a decision if the complaint is valid or not.
- All decisions of the Board are final.

Following the announcement of the awards in May, the Recipient(s) of the scholarship award(s) shall provide the Trustees with copies of a registrar's receipt evidencing the enrollment of the Recipient(s) at a qualifying post-secondary education facility and copies of the Recipient(s) fall semester program of classes at such institution. The above documents must be received by the Trustees prior to September 10th of the year that the scholarship award checks are to be issued. Should the above documents not be received by the Trustees prior to September 10th of the year during which the scholarship has been awarded, the Recipient shall forfeit the scholarship award.

4. *Post graduate applications only* - Additional official transcripts from your current educational institution.
5. A copy of your FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid).
6. The Application Form and all required supporting materials must be postmarked no later than March 15th of the current scholarship year.

CERTIFICATION:

I, the undersigned Applicant, understand that if I am awarded the Outcalt Foundation Scholarship, I must be enrolled and in good standing at least half time at an accredited program at a college or university.

I understand that I must comply with all stated policies and conditions of the Scholarship, and that the funds awarded are to be used for tuition, mandatory fees, course-related expenses, and reasonable living expenses incurred while attending a qualifying post-secondary education educational program.

I understand that my failure to comply with all Outcalt Foundation Scholarship policies and conditions will result in the forfeiture of the entirety or a portion of the Scholarship award. In such event, I will return the entirety or required portion of the Scholarship monies to the Outcalt Foundation promptly upon written demand.

I understand that Trustees of the Foundation, members of the Scholarship Committee and their immediate families are ineligible for the Scholarship. I also understand that all materials submitted to the Foundation will become the property of the Foundation and that the Foundation reserves the right to issue public announcements regarding Scholarship award winners.

I understand that all scholarship decisions are final and at the discretion of the Board of Trustees.
